

Video Performance Requirements

- Present a 2 minute scripted monologue
- Pieces can be from:
 - Plays
 - Collection of monologues
 - Adapted from other sources (e.g.: poetry, storytelling, novels etc.) in any performance style
- The monologue should be a fully realised performance and students must not be prompted with lines or refer to any scripts. Costumes are not expected however if absolutely necessary small props are allowed
 - Ensure audio quality of the video is clear
 - Record your audition in a room with neutral acoustics (not a large hall or outside)
 - Applicants should wear drama blacks or simple comfortable clothing
 - The applicant's full body must be visible in the video at all times
 - Please review the video before sending and ensure that it is appropriate for audition

Assessment Criteria

Applicants will be assessed on:

- Physical and vocal performance skills
- Appropriate use of space
- Ability to create an appropriate role/character
- Control of the pace, rhythm and dynamics of the text
- Ability to create a theatrical narrative that has a sense of clarity and purpose
